Dear NEPA Call-In User:

This letter is in response to your April 3, 1997 request for the Air Force Center for Environmental Excellence (AFCEE) methodology on environmental justice. Specifically, at the recent Environmental Quality Advisory Group (EQAG) meeting, Colonel Thomas Gross of the AFCEE stated they had such a methodology and you would like a copy.

NEPA Call-In contacted Colonel Thomas Gross, Director, Environmental Conservation and Planning, AFCEE, (210) 536-3869, for the requested environmental justice methodology. Colonel Gross stated we could obtain a copy from Mr. Thomas Adamcyk, Economist, Environmental Planning, AFCEE, (210) 536-3765.

We contacted Mr. Adamcyk who provided "Guide for Environmental Justice Analysis with the Environmental Impact Analysis Process (EIAP)," Air Force Center for Environmental Excellence, March 1997 (enclosed).
