Notice of Amendments to the
Request for Offers, 2006-2007, NIB/NISH, Western Distribution
Center and Easter Distribution Center

This serves as notification that the General Services Administration's (GSA's), Freight Management Program (FMP) has made the following amendments to the Request for Offers, 2006-2007, NIB/NISH, Western Distribution Center and Easter Distribution Center.

Section 7, Basis for Determining Applicable Distance/Mileage, has been changed to read Section 7A. No other changes were made to this Section.

Section 7B, Application of 4% Transaction Fee, has been added to include the wording regarding the implementation of a 4% Transaction Fee into the context of the Request for Offers and Special Filing Instructions.

Section 10, Identification of Non-Alternating, Standing Route Order Traffic for the Eastern Distribution Center (EDC), Burlington, NJ, Paragraph 10-23.A. Identification of Truckload Routes, has been amended to reflect corrected zip codes for New Cumberland Army Depot, New Cumberland, PA (EDC32) and Naval Supply Center, Norfolk, VA (EDC33).

Enclosure 2 for Washington, DC Commercial Zone Service Area Codes EDC34 and EDC36 has been amended to remove invalid zip codes.

Enclosure 3 – Service Area Codes EDC31 and EDC35, Manhattan, Bronx, Brooklyn, Queens, Staten Island, Long Island NY Route and Northern New Jersey, has been amended to remove invalid zip codes.
