



**RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON ENVIRONMENT AND PUBLIC WORKS OF THE
UNITED STATES SENATE**

that pursuant to title 40 U.S.C. § 3307, a prospectus requesting the authority for alterations to the Daniel Patrick Moynihan U.S. Courthouse at 500 Pearl Street, New York, NY, due to vacating District Court judges from this courthouse back to the Thurgood Marshall Courthouse, at a cost not to exceed the following amounts for: Design and Review (\$2,031,000); Estimated Construction Costs (\$22,000,000); and Management and Inspection (\$3,969,000) for an estimated total project cost of \$28,000,000, a description of which is attached hereto and by reference made part of this resolution, is approved.
