Supply Chain Challenges

Ongoing disruptions and ongoing supply problems in automotive supply chains leading to:

- Low allocation across vehicle types
- Early and unexpected model closeouts
- Outstanding/extended deliveries
- Potential order cancellations
- Accessories & options missing



Development / Planning

Three main cycles that are dependent on one another:

- 1. Federal Standards which create the schedule of items that go into the solicitation
- Federal standards timeline for establishing IDIQ contracts
- 3. OEM manufacturing model year cycle

Open Seasons

- Programs with Open Seasons include:
 - Light Vehicles & Transit Bus (Available Now!)
 - Vocational & Medium Heavy Trucks (Coming Soon!)
- New process taking the place of Next Model Year
 - Existing contractors can:
 - 1. Update model year and pricing on awarded models (NMY)
 - 2. Propose entirely new models
 - New offerors can:
 - 1. Propose entirely new models
 - 2. Propose the next model year for models on contract
- Federal Standards process
 - AutoStandards / AutoBid
 - Submission templates for cut-off dates and new proposals.

SIN 888E

- SIN 888E is for Emerging Technology, which includes EV and EV-related accessories.
- This SIN is open for proposal submission at any time. This option allows offerors/vendors with Emerging Technology items the ability to add them not subject to open season periods.
- Streamlined for current awardees, and also an opportunity for new vendors to receive contract awards.
- Open Season and 888E allow for NMY offerings while also maintaining flexibility for EVs.



Vehicle Program Timelines

- Light Vehicle
 - POP: 11/8/2021 11/7/2026
 - Open Season: Bi-Annually in the Spring and Fall
- Medium Heavy/Wrecker Carrier
 - POP: 1/9/2023 1/8/2028
 - Open Season: Annually in the Fall
- Main Bus
 - o POP: 10/6/2020 10/5/2024
 - Open Season: NMY annually
- Transit Bus
 - o POP: 12/9/2021 12/8/2026
 - Open Season: Annually in the Fall



Vehicle Program Timelines (cont'd)

- Vocational
 - o POP: 12/21/2022 12/20/2027
 - Open Season: Bi-Annually in the Spring and Fall
- Ambulance
 - o POP: 12/2/2019 3/31/2024
 - Open Season: NMY annually
- Europe
 - o POP: 8/1/2020 11/30/2023
 - Open Season: NMY annually
- Wheelchair
 - POP: 1/26/2021 4/30/2025
 - Open Season: NMY annually



Multiple Award Schedule (MAS)

- The Multiple Award Schedule solicitation is available here: https://sam.gov/opp/7beca3dcd7c5460b882303175c93e767/view
- Vendors can submit an offer to become a Schedule contractor at any time - the solicitation does not close.
- Awarded contracts are refreshed periodically with the latest terms and conditions.
- Contracts are awarded for 5 year base period with three option periods (5 years each).



AREQ Process

- AREQ = Additional Requirements for optional equipment that is not available on the awarded contracts because they are often customized for a specific order.
- AREQ is an option code in AutoChoice. Customer is required to provide:
 - AREQ Worksheet Template
 - IGCE (if applicable)
- AREQs are competed among contract holders who have the line item and other optional equipment selected.

Purchasing Overview

GSA is the mandatory source of new non-tactical vehicle purchases for Executive Agencies, the DoD, and other eligible users (Per 41 C.F.R. § 101-26.502 / FPMR 101-26.501)

AutoChoice online ordering tool to select and compare vehicles

Agencies purchase more than \$1 billion in vehicles and automotive products annually at over 24% below dealer invoice

Professional engineering services including technical assistance and vehicle design services

Professional contracting teams and customer service staff

Assistance with Multiple Award Schedule (MAS) ordering



AutoChoice

- Online ordering tool
- Permits various levels of user rights defined by Agency Fleet Managers.
- Configure vehicles and choose optional equipment
- View side by side comparisons of vehicle models from vendors

- Calculate total price
- View and compare fuel economy and fuel types
- Submit and track your vehicle orders online



Standard Order Program

- Ambulances
- Buses
- Incomplete light-duty cab/chassis
- Law enforcement & upfitting
- Light trucks
- Light trucks with vocational bodies
- Medium and heavy trucks

- Sedans
- Station wagons
- SUVs
- Vans

Additional Requirements (AREQ)

- Is an option code (AREQ) on the Optional Equipment page requires additional documentation
- •Allows customers to request specific equipment not listed in the optional equipment list such as an electric drive train for a school bus, a snow plow, or additional key fobs
- Will result in the manual processing of your order

- List requirements concisely and include enough information for GSA to obtain valid pricing
- Cannot be used to request makes/models not offered in GSA AutoChoice
- Cannot be used to request options shown as not available by the manufacturer



Express Desk

Reserved for an **urgent & compelling need** (FAR 6.302-2(c))



- Request is submitted in AutoChoice
- GSA is required to and will seek three sources for the procurement.
- Customer provides:
 - Names of dealerships within the delivery area to be solicited by GSA
 - Justification for urgent & compelling need and timeframe
- If non-standard vehicle is required or there are specialty needs, provide vehicle specifications
- If a "brand specific" vehicle is required, a complete and comprehensive Justification for Other than Full and Open Competition (JOFOC) must be provided.
- No guarantee
- 2% Fee / 5% fee August-September



Multiple Award Schedule (MAS) (cont.)

- Fire Fighting apparatus and attachments
- Law Enforcement vehicles and attachments
- Special Vocational vehicles and attachments
- Construction equipment and attachments
- Snow Maintenance equipment
- Trailers and attachments

- Aircraft Ground Support vehicles and equipment
- Upfitting services
- Low-Speed vehicles
- Tires
- Leased heavy-duty vehicles and accessories
- Automotive body and repair services



Non-standard Vehicles

- Custom vehicle builds
- For unique and specialized requirements which are not under the SOP contracts or MAS programs
- Work one-on-one with a vehicle engineer to customize any vehicle and the design & build services
- 10% fee for the first vehicle,
 2% for every vehicle after the first within the same project

- Loss Prevention



Customer Acquisition Module (CAM)

Online tool for the selection and approval of replacement and additional vehicles



- Resides within GSA Fleet Drive-thru
- Houses important acquisition documents
 - Agency Guidance
 - GSA Fleet Rate Bulletin
 - AFV Guide
- Includes a review hierarchy unique to each agency
 - Local customer
 - Mid-level (optional)
 - HQ
- Provides agencies the ability to request/approve/track their vehicle replacements and additional vehicles
- Ability to add comments and attach documents for improved communication within the agency and with GSA Fleet
- Follows a timeline to ensure vehicles are approved and ordered in a timely manner



Short Term Vehicle/Equipment Rental

- Seasonal or Surge Requirements
- <120 days for vehicles
- Up to 1 year for equipment
- STR On Demand

Purchasing Outside of GSA (waivers)

Email/letter to vehicle.buying@gsa.gov with the following information:

- 1. A statement that the agency agrees to comply with all applicable federal laws and rules to include but not limited to:
 - the Statutory Price Limitations, Buy America Act, Free Trade Agreement, Mandatory Source (Sole Source Justification needs to be attached, if applicable) etc.
- 4. Vehicle type(s), quantity(s), make(s), model(s), specifications, and options.
- 5. Any available cost data pertaining to the requested vehicle(s).
- 6. Known sources of supply for requested vehicle(s).




Purchasing Outside of GSA (waivers) (cont.)

- 7. Procurement method to be used.
- 8. Justification for purchasing outside of GSA.
- 9. The name, agency, position title, phone number, full mailing address, and e-mail address of the following individuals:
 - a. Agency HQ Fleet Manager
 - b. Requestor of waiver
 - c. Local point of contact/end user of the vehicle(s)
 - d. Financial Officer Authorizing Fund Availability for this procurement
 - e. Contracting Officer conducting this procurement
 - f. Competition Advocate or Senior Procurement Executive (SPE)
