## Payment and Removal

GSA accepts payment in a variety of forms, including U.S. currency (no greater than \$10,000); bank cashier's checks; money orders; traveler's checks; U.S. federal, state, or local government checks; credit cards; and online payment through the Department of Treasury's electronic-payment service [www.pay.gov](http://www.pay.gov) via GSA Auctions<sup>SM</sup>. Purchasers are required to remove their items within the time prescribed for each sale, after payment is made. If a purchaser fails to pay and remove the merchandise by the prescribed time frame, the purchaser will be considered in default, and liquidated damages will apply.
