Project Overview

Design and Construction of a new Land Port of Entry (LPOE) while using and maintaining the original historic land port of entry as part of the LPOE campus. The project will provide new construction to supplement the existing facility with a new state-of-the-art and expanded capacity facility.

Current Status

The Construction Manager as Advisor (CMa) contract was awarded in February 2023. The CMa will assist with the preparation of a design build requirements package. A National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) contract was awarded a task order to study the proposed action in December 2022.
