beta.SAM.gov is a production website that will eventually become the centralized, authoritative source of federal award data, consolidated from 10 legacy systems. When the consolidation is complete, you can seamlessly leverage vast stores of data, discover a wide range of award

opportunities, and make more informed and effective award decisions. The integrated website will simplify daily tasks and increase business knowledge by providing one powerful search tool, one robust reporting tool, and one workspace for managing your work.

WHAT CAN YOU DO IN BETA.SAM.GOV?

- Try out our search capabilities across all public data from CFDA, FBO, FPDS, SAM.gov, and WDOL
- Use the handy feedback tool on the new site to provide your comments on functions and features
- Become familiar with the terminology used on the new site
- Visit our searchable learning center with videos, glossary, FAQs, articles, alerts, and release notes
- Check beta.SAM.gov for the latest news and to see what features are coming next
- The remaining operational systems will run parallel with beta.SAM.gov and remain the authoritative sources until they are retired.
- CFDA was the first system to retire. WDOL, FBO, and SAM are next in line to fully transition to beta.SAM.gov.
- Once SAM.gov transitions, the name of the beta.SAM.gov site will return to simply SAM.gov.
- Existing data and roles will migrate seamlessly from legacy websites to the beta site.
