





- 24 executive agencies
- 88% of those surveyed completed the evaluation
- Final assessments provided to agencies
- Published the 2009 Policy Evaluation Report

This chart shows the percentage of mandates and best practices in all six policy areas that were scored effective, moderately effective, or ineffective

## Strengths

- **Strong Collaboration/Policy Development:** There are strong working relationships between GSA and executive agencies through various interagency councils/committees convened to develop and implement government-wide policies.
- **Strong Mechanisms for Collecting Agency Information:** GSA's mechanisms for collecting agency's information (forms, systems, tools) helped agencies' respond to mandatory requirements.
- **Adherence Supports Agency Missions:** Seventy-two percent of the participating stakeholders concur that participating in the policy evaluation process increased the agency's attention to policy area(s).

## Weaknesses

- **Policy Implementation:** Agencies continue to struggle to implement some policies. Agencies' self-disclosed reasons for not adhering to mandates included lack of personnel, lack of funding, other priorities, or adherence planned at a future date.
- **Policy Evaluation Effort:** Some Federal agencies struggle to see the benefits of GSA's policy evaluation program.
- **Dissemination of Information:** GSA should develop mechanisms to disseminate information more quickly and widely.
- **Awareness of Best Practices:** Agencies continue to struggle to identify, adopt, and implement best practices.

## Opportunities

- **Web-Based Reporting Tools:** GSA should develop tools for agencies to provide standardized annual reports using on-line collaboration tools.
- **Increased Training and Policy Awareness:** Agencies identified that GSA should expand and strengthen efforts to the Policy Evaluation Program by providing training and education to executive agencies.

## Threats

- **Program-Specific Policy Implementation:** The failure to implement government-wide mandates poses a potential threat to the effective and efficient management of government-wide programs leading to agency's inability to meet its strategic objectives.

OGP, in collaboration with our stakeholders and agency users, applies this information to improve policies and stimulate more efficient operations and effective management practices. However, with shrinking budgets and resources, agencies will continue to face challenges when implementing these policies.


#### Data Collection Form (DCF) Submission Process

Submitting the DCF for each policy area will follow this series of steps, as shown in the figure below:

1. Your agency completes the "Mandates", "Best Practices", "Other Program Information" (if applicable; not all DCFs will include this section), and "OGP/MT Feedback" sections.
2. Your agency approving official reviews the completed form, completes their portion of the "OGP/MT Feedback" section, and submits the DCF to GSA for review and scoring.
3. GSA provides interim and/or final scores based on the agency's responses and returns the form to your agency.
4. Where GSA has assigned interim scores, your agency will have an opportunity to provide additional information. When your agency has done that and completed the "CPE Feedback" section, the updated DCF is re-submitted to GSA for final scoring through the agency approving official.
5. GSA provides final scoring on all questions within the "Mandates" sections, and acknowledges feedback provided by the agency in the other sections.

An agency mail manager should: (a) Establish written policies and procedures to provide timely and cost effective dispatch and delivery of mail; (b) Ensure agency-wide awareness and compliance with standards and operational procedures established by all service providers used by the agency; (c) Set policies for expedited mail, mass mailings, mailing lists, and couriers; (d) Seek opportunities to implement cost-effective improvements and to enhance performance of the agency's mission; (e) Develop and direct agency programs and plans for proper and cost-effective use of transportation equipment, and supplies used for mail; (f) Ensure that facility and program level mail personnel receive appropriate certifications and training in order to successfully perform their assigned duties; (g) Promote professional certification for mail managers and mail center employees; (h) Ensure that expedited mail and couriers are used only when authorized by the Private Express Statutes and when necessary and cost-effective; (i) Establish written policies and procedures to minimize incoming and outgoing personal mail; (j) Provide guidance to agency correspondence managers on correspondence management decisions such as development and design of mailing materials including Business Reply Mail, letterhead, and mail piece design; and (k) Represent the agency in its relations with mail service providers, other agency mail managers, and the GSA Office of Governmentwide Policy.
