

U.S. GOVERNMENT
LEASE FOR REAL PROPERTY

THIS LEASE, made and entered into this date between **PARK PLACE HOLDINGS, LP**

whose address is: 1401 Fulton Street, Suite 210
Fresno, CA 93721-1644

and whose interest in the property hereinafter described is that of OWNER, hereinafter called the LESSOR, and the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, hereinafter called the GOVERNMENT:

WITNESSETH: The parties hereto for the considerations hereinafter mentioned, covenant and agree as follows:

1. The Lessor hereby leases to the Government the following described premises:
16,444 rentable square feet (r.s.f.), yielding approximately 14,592 ANSI/BOMA Office Area square feet and related space located on the 3rd Floor at Park Place, 7815 North Palm Avenue, Fresno, CA 93711-5531 together with 12 onsite structured parking spaces and 15 onsite reserved/outside parking spaces, plus the possibility of 4 additional spaces during the term, as depicted on the attached Exhibit A (Floor Plan), to be used for SUCH PURPOSES AS DETERMINED BY THE GENERAL SERVICES ADMINISTRATION.
2. PARAGRAPH 2 IS INTENTIONALLY OMITTED.
3. PARAGRAPH 3 IS INTENTIONALLY OMITTED.
4. The Government may terminate this lease in whole or in part effective any time after the tenth (10th) year of this lease giving at least ninety (90) calendar days prior notice in writing to the Lessor. No rental shall accrue after the effective date of termination. Said notice shall be computed commencing with the day after the date of mailing.
5. PARAGRAPH 5 IS INTENTIONALLY OMITTED.

6. The Lessor shall furnish to the Government as part of the rental consideration, the following:
- A. The parking space(s) described in Paragraph 1 and parking spaces required by local code.
 - B. All labor, materials, equipment, design, professional fees, permit fees, inspection fees, utilities, construction drawings (including, without limitation, plans and specifications), construction costs and services and all other similar costs and expenses associated with making the space, common areas, and related facilities ready for occupancy in accordance with the requirements of this lease and the Government's approved Design Intent Drawings. Rent is subject to adjustment in accordance with Paragraph 3.3 "Tenant Improvement Rental Adjustment" of the SFO. All cost associated with services, utilities, maintenance, repair, replacement, inspections, improvements and other requirements as required by the Solicitation For Offers No. LCA02608 and its attachments.
 - C. Adequate space for telecommunications antennae and transmission devices in accordance with Paragraph entitled, "Telecommunications: Local Exchange Access," of the Solicitation for Offers.

7. The following are attached and made a part hereof:

- g) Special Requirements, Attachment 1A- Part 1 (pages 1-21) and Attachment 1B - Part 2 (pages 1-28);
- h) GSA Form 3517- General Clauses (pages 1-33);
- i) GSA Form 3518 - Representations and Certifications (pages 1-7)

8. The following changes were made in this lease prior to its execution:

Paragraphs 2, 3 and 5 of this STANDARD FORM 2 were deleted in their entirety. Paragraphs 9 through 23 have been added.

9. **TO HAVE AND TO HOLD** the said Premises with their appurtenances for the term beginning on the day the space is accepted by the Government as complete and ready for occupancy through the following Fifteen (15) years term in accordance with the Paragraph entitled "Acceptance of Space" herein, subject to termination rights as may be hereinafter set forth.
10. The Government shall pay the Lessor annual rent as follows:

For Year One (1) through Year Four (4) the annual rent of \$486,290.13 (consisting of \$281,192.40 (\$17.10 per rsf/yr) shell rent, operating cost of \$102,939.44 (\$6.26 per rsf/yr), and \$102,158.29 (\$6.21 per rsf/yr) Amortized Tenant Improvements) payable at the rate of \$40,524.18 per month in arrears, subject to the rent abatement provision below.

RENT ABATEMENT

Months One (1) through Month Four (4) are subject to Shell Rent abatement in the amount of \$23,432.70 (per month), consisting of a total abatement of \$93,730.80. During this four month period the monthly rent shall be \$17,091.48

For Year Five (5) through Year Seven (7) the annual rent of \$547,297.37 (consisting of \$342,199.64 (\$20.81 per rsf/yr) shell rent, operating cost of \$102,939.44 (\$6.26 per rsf/yr), and \$102,158.29 (\$6.21 per rsf/yr) Amortized Tenant Improvements) payable at the rate of \$45,608.11 per month in arrears.

For Year Eight (8) through Year Ten (10) the annual rent of \$615,539.97 (consisting of \$410,442.24 (\$24.96 per rsf/yr) shell rent, operating cost of \$102,939.44 (\$6.26 per rsf/yr), and \$102,158.29 (\$6.21 per rsf/yr) Amortized Tenant Improvements) payable at the rate of \$51,295.00 per month in arrears.

For Year Eleven (11) through Year Fifteen (15) the annual rent of \$692,456.84 (consisting of \$589,517.40 (\$35.85 per rsf/yr) shell rent and operating cost of \$102,939.44 (\$6.26 per rsf/yr), at the rate of \$57,704.74 payable per month in arrears.

Rent for a lesser period shall be prorated. Rent shall be payable to:

11. The Lessor shall have one hundred and twenty (120) calendar days from the receipt of the Government's Notice to Proceed to complete the build-out of the entire space. All items specified in Lease Agreement and as delineated on the Government Approved Design Intent Drawings shall be provided by the Lessor.
12. **TAX ADJUSTMENT:** Pursuant to Paragraph 4.2, "Tax Adjustment," for purposes of tax escalation, the Government occupies 16,444 / 96,378 rentable square feet (0.17062%).
13. **OPERATING COST:** Pursuant to Paragraph 4.3, "Operating Costs", the base rate for purposes of operating cost escalation is established at \$6.26 per rentable square foot per annum.
14. **ADJUSTMENT FOR VACANT PREMISES:** Pursuant to Paragraph 4.4, "Adjustment for Vacant Premises", in the event of the Government vacating in whole or in part prior to lease expiration, the rental will be reduced by \$2.40 per rentable square foot per annum for operating expenses. The Adjustment for Vacant Premises rate shall be escalated annually based upon Paragraph 4.4, "Operating Costs."
15. **OVERTIME USAGE:** Pursuant to Paragraph 4.6, "Overtime Usage", upon request by the GSA Field Office Manager, the Lessor shall provide heating, ventilation, and air-conditioning (HVAC) at any time beyond normal service hours (7:00 a.m. - 6:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, and 8:00 a.m. - 1:00 p.m. Saturdays) and except Federal Holidays, at an hourly rate of \$10.10 per hour for the entire premises. The Lessor will not charge the Government if Lessor otherwise provides these services to other building tenants during the Government's overtime hours. The Lessor must submit a proper invoice quarterly to GSA Building Manager or designee located at GSA, Central California Field Office, 345 Middlefield Road, Menlo Park, CA 94025 to receive payment.
16. **24 HOUR ROOMS:** The Overtime Usage rate specified above shall not apply to any portion of the Premises that is required to have heating and cooling 24 hours per day as specified by the Lease. The charges for heating and cooling of these areas shall be provided at the rate of \$0.36 per Rentable square foot per hour after "Normal Hours".
17. **TENANT IMPROVEMENT ALLOWANCE:** The maximum Tenant Improvement Allowance has been established by Paragraph 3.2A, "Tenant Improvements Included in Offer." The Tenant Improvement Allowance shall be amortized over the ten (10) year firm term of the lease agreement at an interest rate (amortization rate) of 7.25 % per year.

18. BUDGET AND PRICE PROPOSALS/CONSTRUCTION SCHEDULE:

- A. The price proposal required to be provided by Lessor in SFO Paragraph 5.11(E), "Tenant Improvements Price Proposal," must be based upon the results of a competitive proposal process meeting all of the requirements of SFO Paragraph 5.2, B (1) through (10), entitled, "Tenant Improvements Pricing Requirements." The Government has the right, but not the obligation, to accept cost or pricing data as described in GSA Form 3517 in lieu of a competitive price proposal.
- B. Failure to submit these budget and price proposals referenced above will constitute Lessor delay. In the event that either the budget proposal or price proposal exceeds the Tenant Improvement Allowance specified in the Lease, then the construction schedule shall be revised to afford the Government sufficient time to review and resolve the difference.
- C. The construction schedule required in Paragraph 5.11 (F), "Construction of Tenant Improvements," of the SFO shall also include adequate time for additional review by the Government of revised design intent drawings and Working Drawings/Construction Drawings. All references to "working days" in Paragraph 5.11, "Construction Schedule and Acceptance of Tenant Improvements" of the SFO shall not include the period from December 15 through January 1 of any calendar year.
- D. In addition to the submission requirements specified under Paragraph 5.11, "Construction Schedule and Acceptance of Tenant Improvements," Lessor shall provide to the Government the final total costs of the completed Tenant Improvements in CSI format fifteen (15) working days prior to "Substantial Completion". The space will not be considered acceptable for inspection until the Government receives the final tenant improvement costs.

19. ACCEPTANCE OF SPACE:

- A. The following is added to Paragraph 5.11 G (1), "Acceptance of Space and Certificate of Occupancy": Subsequent Government inspections and notification of the results of such inspections shall be made in accordance with the foregoing procedure. Time frames for subsequent inspections will be established by the Government.
- B. Any items that have been identified at the acceptance of the space as punchlist items to be completed or corrected and which do not affect beneficial occupancy shall be completed by the Lessor within 30 calendar days of acceptance.
- C. Neither the Government's acceptance of the Premises for occupancy or acceptance of related appurtenances, nor the Government's occupancy of the Premises, shall be construed as a waiver of any requirement or right of the Government under this lease, or as otherwise prejudicing the Government with respect to any such requirement or right, or as an acceptance of any latent defect or condition

20. UNAUTHORIZED IMPROVEMENTS: All questions pertaining to this lease agreement shall be referred in writing to the General Services Administration Contracting Officer. This contract is between GSA and the Lessor. GSA assumes no financial responsibility for any cost incurred by the Lessor except as provided by the terms of the lease agreement or authorized in writing by the GSA Contracting Officer. **If Lessor delivers space with improvements not authorized or requested in writing by the GSA Contracting Officer, then Lessor shall not be entitled to compensation.**

21. Wherever the words "Offeror", "Lessor" or "successful offeror" appear in this Lease, they shall be deemed to mean "Lessor"; wherever the words "solicitation", "Solicitation for Offers", or "SFO" appear in this Lease, they shall be deemed to mean "this Lease"; wherever the words "space offered for lease" appear in this Lease, they shall be deemed to mean "Premises".

22. Pursuant to Paragraph 5.1, "Unit Costs for Adjustments", the negotiated amounts (Exhibit "A" - Unit Price List) may be used during the first year of the lease to price alterations costing \$100,000 or less. These prices may be indexed or renegotiated to apply to subsequent years of the lease upon mutual agreement of the Lessor and the Government.

23. COMMISSION AND COMMISSION CREDIT:

The Lessor and the Broker have agreed to a cooperating lease commission of [REDACTED] of the firm term value of this lease. The total amount of the commission is [REDACTED] (rent rebate not included). The Lessor shall pay the Broker no additional commissions associated with this lease transaction. In accordance with the "Broker Commission and Commission Credit" paragraph, the Broker has agreed to forego [REDACTED] of the commission that it is entitled to receive in connection with this lease transaction ("Commission Credit"). The Commission Credit is [REDACTED]. The Lessor agrees to pay the Commission less the Commission Credit to the Broker in accordance with the "Broker Commission and Commission Credit" paragraph in the SFO attached to and forming a part of this lease.

Notwithstanding Paragraph 10 of this Standard Form 2, the shell rental payments due and owing under this lease shall be reduced to fully recapture this Commission Credit. The reduction in shell rent shall commence with the fifth month of the rental payments and continue as indicated in this schedule for adjusted Monthly Rent:
