The Federal Footprint

- \$500 billion on goods and services in FY 2008
- 645,000 non-tactical vehicles worldwide
- Single largest domestic buyer and user of energy
- Purchases about \$74 billion of IT equipment and services per year.





Executive Orders

- Executive Order 13423
 - Requires acquisition of biobased, environmentally preferable, energy-efficient, water-efficient, and recycled content products

- Executive Order 13514
 - **95% of new contract actions must be green!**
 - Includes task and delivery orders
 - Applies where such products and services meet agency performance requirements



Legislation

- Recycled content: Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA), Section 6002
- Biobased content: Farm Security and Rural Investment Act (2002 Farm Bill), Section 9002
- Energy efficient products and alternative fuel vehicles: Energy Policy Act of 1992 and 2005
- Building energy efficiency: Energy Independence and Security Act of 2007
- Non-ozone depleting substances: Clean Air Act
- Chemicals: Pollution Prevention Act of 1990
