Dear Mr. Biederman:

The National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA) completed a review of its property holdings at the Santa Susana Field Laboratory (SSFL) in Ventura County, California, and determined SSFL is not needed by NASA to meet current or future mission requirements.

NASA requests that the General Services Administration (GSA), under its authority and in compliance with the Federal Property and Administrative Services Act of 1949, as amended (40 U.S.C. §§471 et seq), take action for disposition of SSFL. Additionally, NASA satisfied its responsibility under Section 207 of the National Aeronautics and Space Act of 1958, as amended, (42 U.S.C. §2476a) to provide notice to the appropriate Congressional committees prior to reporting SSFL as excess to GSA. NASA provided notice to Congress on April 12, 2009, and did not receive a Congressional notice of objection of the proposed excess.

Please be advised that the enclosed NASA Santa Susana Report of Excess contains information related to cultural resources in documents that have not been made public (pages 691-722, 1550, 1560-1658), nor should be made public without NASA's approval. The pages that contain this information are marked "Not for Public Release."

NASA coordinated the preliminary actions for SSFL disposition with GSA and looks forward to continued coordination with GSA on this important project.
