This is a revision to the spend plan submitted on March 5, 2010 (rev) detailing how GSA will expend the \$5.55 billion authorized by the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act ("Recovery Act"), including measures necessary to convert Federal buildings into high-performance green buildings, renovate and construct Federal buildings and courthouses, and renovate and construct land ports of entry (LPOE).

GSA takes great pride in the progress we have made to obligate Recovery Act funds. We are contributing to our nation's economic recovery through our reinvestments in our public buildings and we are supporting the President's vision for a clean energy future. As of May 21, 2010, we have obligated more than \$4.1 billion of the Recovery Act funds allocated to GSA and are on-track to obligate \$5 billion by the end of fiscal year 2010. As part of our due diligence, we closely monitor contract awards, obligations and outlays and regularly review our spend plan progress to determine if revisions are appropriate.

We continue to realize project costs below our original cost estimates and are reprogramming these funds to other projects to keep Recovery funds flowing into the economy, to meet our obligation deadlines established in the Act and to further the impact of our high performance green building investments.

Based on our cost projections, we are submitting a revised spend plan that adjusts spend plan allocations for existing projects to reprogram project savings, address unforeseen circumstances, modify existing projects to include additional high-performance green features and to add eight additional new projects, primarily in the Land Port of Entry project category. In a few isolated instances we are returning funds to projects where there were previous reductions. Earlier reductions on these projects in previous spend plans was done to make funds available for obligation to fund projects that were ready for award and where there was an immediate need. This enabled GSA to meet its previously stated obligation milestones.

As with our initial spend plan, we reviewed refinements to projects and project modifications based on two overarching criteria: Ability of the project to put people back to work quickly, and transforming Federal buildings into high-performance green buildings.

A nationally managed, regionally executed Program Management Office is actively monitoring all Recovery Act projects. The office is staffed with experts in various fields to support the regional teams delivering the projects.
