Federal Building located at 600 Arch Street in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania at a cost not to exceed \$48,450,000 for construction; and a management and inspection cost of \$3,850,000, for a total cost of \$52,300,000, a description of which is attached hereto and by reference made part of this resolution, is approved.
