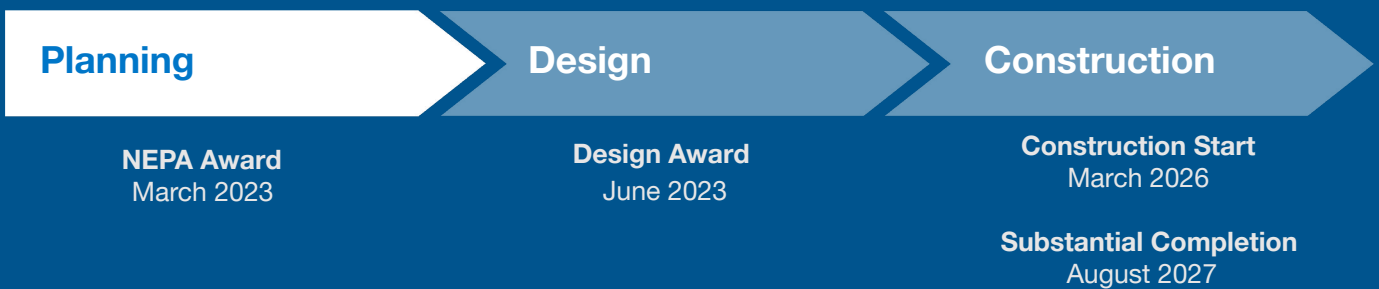
Project Overview

The overall project entails Repair & Alteration (R&A) of the existing Land Port Of Entry (LPOE) facility. Repairs include: expanded inbound and outbound canopy, enclosed vehicle search area, soft secondary inspection canopy, employee parking, and interior renovation of existing facility to meet updated Customs and Border Protection (CBP) program of requirements.

Current Status

A Design Statement of Work is being developed for the renovations and alterations to the existing Historic Main Port Building. In addition, a Design-Build contract is anticipated to construct the new access road for the adjoining properties. The acquisition process to bring on a contractor to perform the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) process is underway with an anticipated award in March of 2023.

Project Timeline



The Bipartisan Infrastructure Law includes \$3.4 billion for GSA to modernize and construct land ports of entry along the nation's borders. These projects will strengthen supply chains, create good-paying jobs, enhance safety and security, and serve as models of sustainability.
