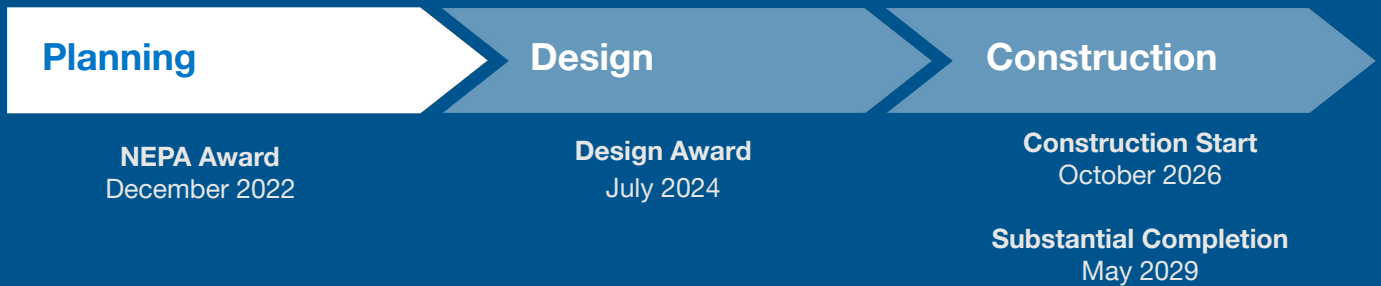
Project Overview

The project will help Customs and Border Protection (CBP) to more efficiently carry out its agency mission at the international border crossing between Coburn Gore, Maine, and Woburn, Quebec.

Current Status

The team is developing a statement of work for pre-design services to be awarded in March 2023. The National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) contract was awarded in December of 2022.

Project Timeline



The Bipartisan Infrastructure Law includes \$3.4 billion for GSA to modernize and construct land ports of entry along the nation's borders. These projects will strengthen supply chains, create good-paying jobs, enhance safety and security, and serve as models of sustainability.
