COMMITTEE RESOLUTION

AMENDED PROSPECTUS - ALTERATION JACOB K. JAVITS FEDERAL BUILDING COMPLEX NEW YORK, NY PNY-0282-NY25

Resolved by the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure of the United States House of Representatives, that pursuant to 40 U.S.C. § 3307, appropriations are authorized for a repair and alteration project for the Jacob K. Javits Federal Office Building (Javits FOB) Complex located at 26 Federal Plaza in New York, NY, to upgrade the legacy fire alarm system in approximately half of the Javits FOB Complex to match the modern fire alarm system partially installed, demolish and abate select space and build out new space for both the Department of Justice's Antitrust Division and the National Labor Relations Board for a total estimated project cost of \$37,195,000, a prospectus for which is attached to and included in this resolution.

Provided further, that the United States General Services Administration shall not delegate to any agency the authority granted by this resolution.

Provided further, not later than 30 calendar days after the date on which a request from the Chair or Ranking Member of the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure of the House of Representatives is received by the Administrator of General Services, the Administrator shall provide such Member a response in writing that provides any information requested regarding the project.
