

COMMITTEE RESOLUTION

**CONSTRUCTION
NEW U.S. COURTHOUSE
HUNTSVILLE, AL**

**RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON ENVIRONMENT AND PUBLIC WORKS OF
THE UNITED STATES SENATE**

that pursuant to 40 U.S.C. §3307, additional appropriations are authorized for the site work, design, and construction of a new U.S. Courthouse of approximately 123,100 gross square feet, including 26 parking spaces, in Huntsville, AL, at an additional cost of \$23,537,000, for a total project cost of \$110,000,000, a factsheet for which is attached to and included in this resolution. This resolution amends the authorization of the Committee on February 5, 2019, of Prospectus No. PAL-CTC-HU18.

Provided, that the Administrator shall provide to the Chairman or Ranking Member of the Committee on Environment and Public Works of the Senate, in a timely manner, requested documents and information regarding this prospectus and resulting contractual materials, without redaction other than redactions to exclude business confidential, proprietary, and/or procurement sensitive information.

Provided, that the General Services Administration shall not delegate to any other agency the authority granted by this resolution.
