New progress

- Installed cattle gates and chutes at the USDA-APHIS barn.
- Completed furniture installation within the USDA-APHIS office area.
- Begun drywall installation at the Main Building public waiting area soffit.
- Completed Phase Two parking deck support steel.
- Begun Phase Two parking deck corrugated metal facade panel installation.
- Completed I-81 retaining wall.
- Begun construction of the Outbound Inspection Building screen wall.
- Completed installation of the Outbound Inspection Building stairs.
- Begun fabrication of the structural steel for the prow.

Look ahead

- Begin commissioning and testing of mechanical and life safety equipment at the USDA-APHIS Building.
- Install roof coping to complete the building enclosure at the USDA-APHIS Building.
- Ongoing interior work within the Main Building and Outbound Buildings.
- Ongoing installation of infrastructure for lane technology.

Project facts

- **Scope:** Facility-wide modernization and expansion.
- Cost: \$215 million
- Congressional appropriations:
 Phase one funding appropriated in fiscal year 2016 budget.
- Phase two funding appropriated in fiscal year 2018 in the amount of approximately \$133 million.
- **Contract:** Awarded in June 2017 to Northland/Cianbro Joint Venture.

Project estimated timeline

- April 2021 Substantial completion of the USDA APHIS Building
- September 2021 Substantial completion of the overhead parking deck.
- September 2021 Substantial completion of the new Main Building
- August 2022 Substantial completion of Phase Two.
- **September 2022** Contract completion.
