

Non-Contract Part Number ordering with GSA

This guide will explain how to add an item to a material master.

From there, follow your ordering procedures for placing the order.



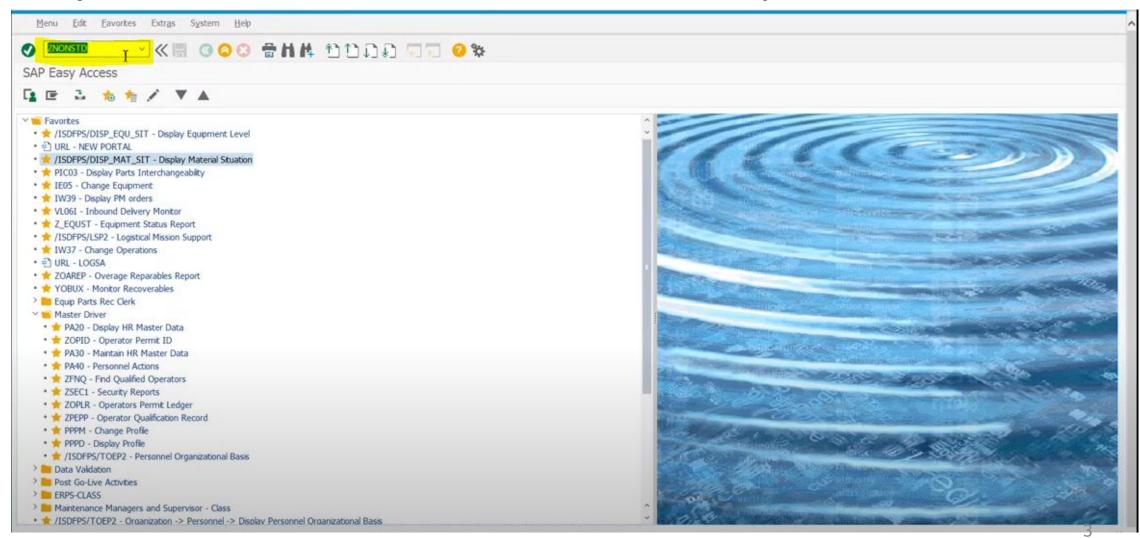
Request Non-Standard Material where GSA is the source of supply

Perform this transaction when you need to create a material master request for a COTS non-standard material in GCSS-Army using the item catalog provided by GSA Vendors or by GSA

NOTE: All items must be approved in AESIP prior to ordering, and orders that transmit to GSA without this approval may be subject to cancellation.



Type Transaction Codes (T Code) **ZNONSTD** in the SAP Easy Access screen Command field and press Enter





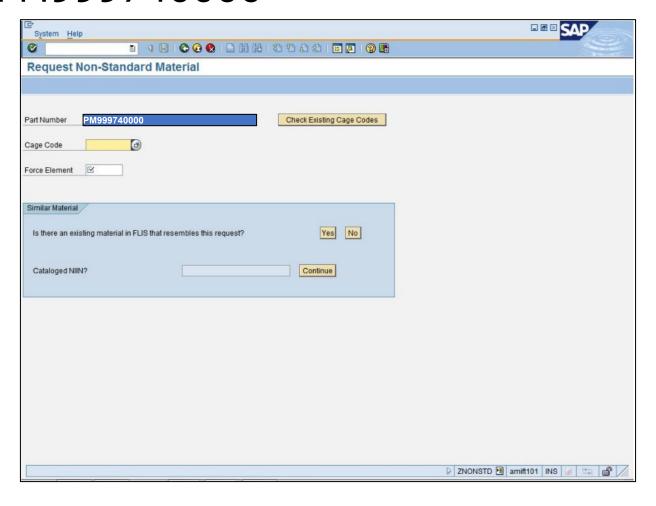
Request Non-Standard Material where GSA is the source of supply

Field	Purpose	Example	Who provides this data?
Manufacturer part number	The MANP is an ID number assigned by the manufacturer to an item. If the material does not have a part number, the model number can be used	PM99974000	GSA/catalog at https://d2d.gsa.gov/report/gsa- global-supply-non-contract-par t-number-catalog-0
Commercial and government entity code (CAGE)	The CAGE code is a five-position, alphanumeric code that corresponds to the manufacturer of the part assigned	3BUS5	GSA/catalog https://d2d.gsa.gov/report/gsa-global-supply-non-contract-part-number-catalog-0
Similar Material	Check yes if the part number can be connected to National Item Identification Number (NIIN)	No	Perform Part number lookup in FLIS, FedLog, or Publog

Format: PM999740000

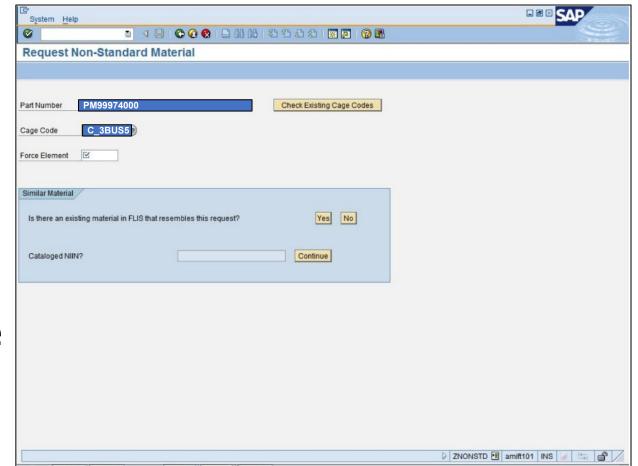




Enter the Manufacturer CAGE code of the COTS non-standard material in the Cage Code field

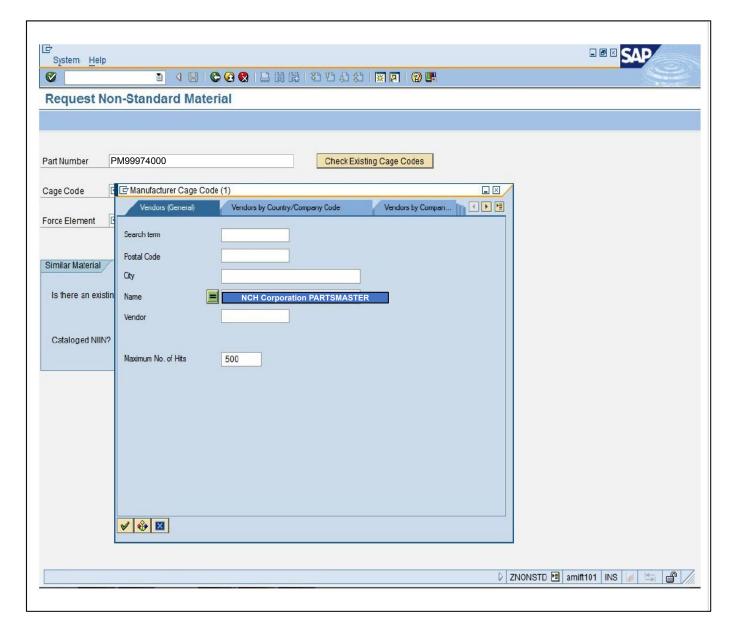
Format: C_3BUS5

If you do not know the Cage use the Cage Code Search



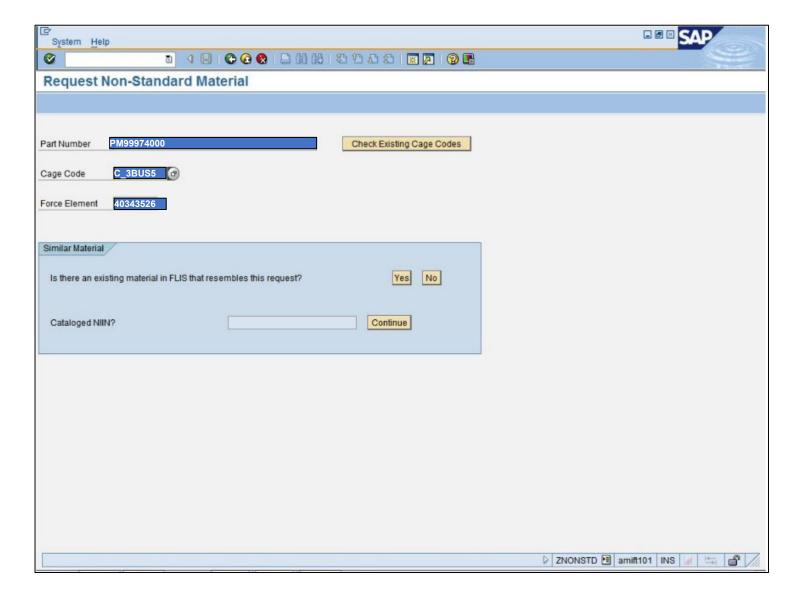


- Click the Cage Code search help button to search for the cage code
- Enter the name of the vendor
 - Example, NCH Corporation PARTSMASTER
- Click the Start Search button to search for the specified vendor.



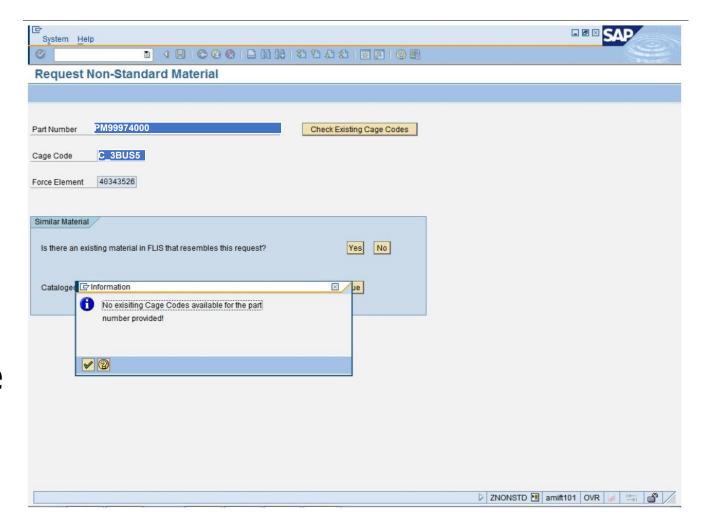

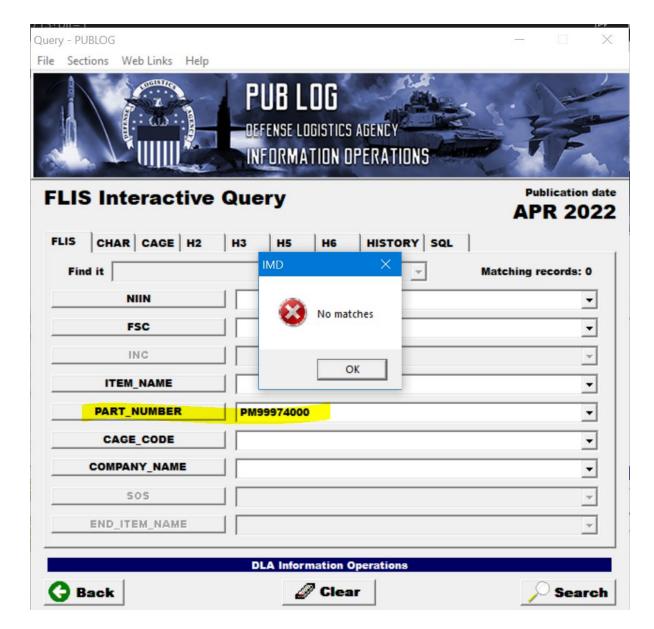
- Use Check Existing Cage Codes

- If message received that no existing Cage Codes available check for similar material



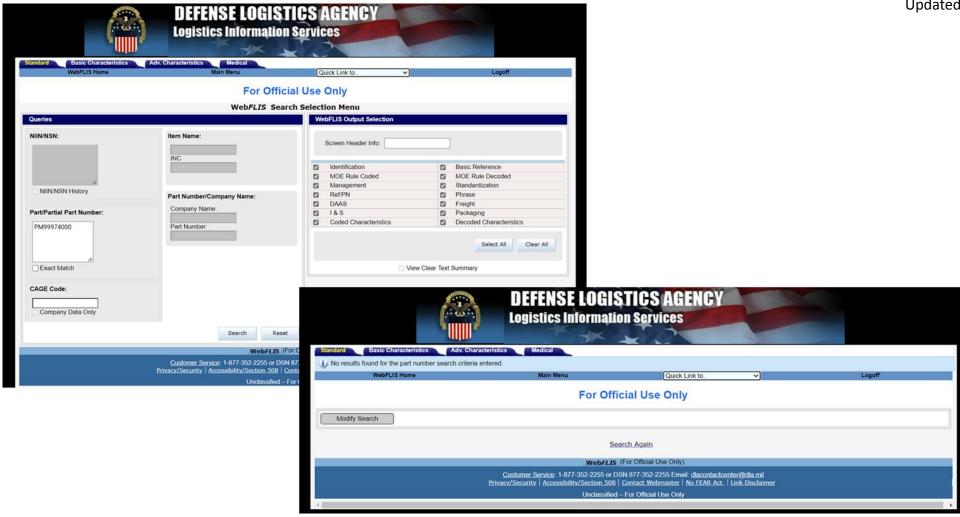


Check FEDLOG/FLIS via PUB LOG for Similar Material cataloged as an NSN

OR, Check FEDLOG/FLIS via WebFLIS for Similar Material cataloged as an NSN

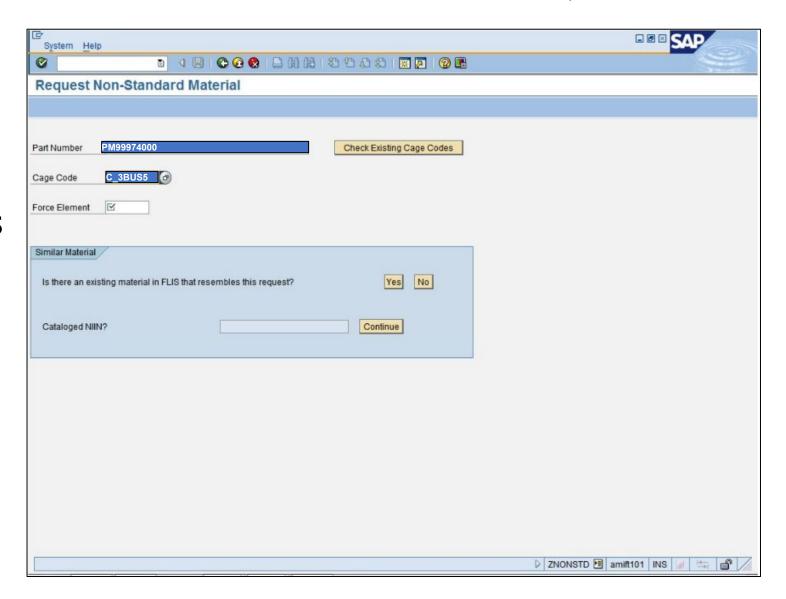
Example search if Part Number is **not** associated with NIIN

If the FEDLOG/FLIS part number search indicates no matches then select to "Is there existing material in FLIS that resembles this request?"

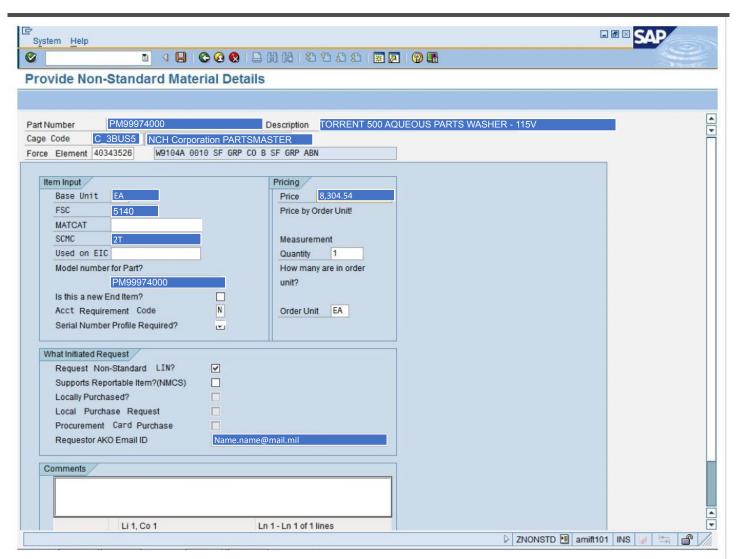

Field	Purpose	Example	Who provides?
GSA Sell price	This is the price of each unit in U.S. dollars. The value entered in this field must be greater than or equal to \$0.01	8,304.54	GSA/catalog at https://d2d.gsa.gov/report/gsa- global-supply-non-contract-par t-number-catalog-0
Accounting requirements code	The accounting requirements code (ARC) is a one-position, alphabetic code assigned to an item.	Acceptable values are: • X (expendable) • N (nonexpendable) or • D (durable)	Army

Reminders

- Sub-micro vs micro+
 - Orders under \$10,000 will be competed and awarded to the low quote without further required documentation from the customer
 - Orders \$10,000 or more, customers will be required to provide Salient Characteristics and must approve of a Brand Name or Equal (BNOE; i.e, substitutes allowed) acquisition
 - Customer will be consulted to approve any substitutes before purchase is completed
- Splitting requirements just to get under the \$10,000 threshold is **prohibited** per <u>FAR 13.003(c)(2)</u>, and your order(s) will be subject to cancellation if we find any indication or appearance of ordering activities engaging in this practice.



- Contact Information mandatory from the ordering individual
 - We must have an email address with your incoming order, particularly for orders over \$10,000
- Do not order Part Numbers (PN) when an NSN is available for the same item. GSA publishes its non-contract PN catalog list at this location:
