INTRODUCTION TO DECEMBER 2021

AIR SAMPLING REPORTS

The following reports are from a sampling event from November 29 through December 8, 2021, where air samples were collected at representative interior locations throughout the Goodfellow Federal Center. A total of 110 air samples, plus 15 blanks, were collected from within 13 buildings. Samples were analyzed for seven target metals: arsenic, barium, cadmium, chromium, lead, selenium, and silver. The testing was part of GSA's continual check for airborne levels of heavy metals by taking air samples inside tenant spaces at least twice a year.

No detectable levels of arsenic, barium, cadmium, chromium, lead, selenium, or silver were found in any air sample or blank. No further action is required at this time.
