Project Overview

The overall project entails Repair & Alteration (R&A) of the existing Land Port Of Entry (LPOE) facility. Repairs include: expanded inbound and outbound canopy, enclosed vehicle search area, soft secondary inspection canopy, employee parking, and interior renovation of existing facility to meet updated Customs and Border Protection (CBP) program of requirements.

Current Status

Marble Fairbanks was contracted to design the renovations and alterations to the existing Historic Main Port Building. A National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) process is underway. The construction manager as advisor (CMa) solicitation is currently underway and is expected to be awarded in early 2024.



The Bipartisan Infrastructure Law includes \$3.4 billion for GSA to modernize and construct land ports of entry along the nation's borders. These projects will strengthen supply chains, create good-paying jobs, enhance safety and security, and serve as models of sustainability.
