Authority for Cooperative Purchasing

The two main authorities for the Cooperative Purchasing program are:

- ☐ Public Law 107-137: Section 211 of the e-Gov Act of 2002, which allows purchase from Schedule 70
- ☐ Public Law 110-248: Local Preparedness Acquisition Act, which allows purchase from Schedule 84



Eligibility

Eligible Users per 40 U.S.C § 502 (c) offers the following definition of State or Local government:

"...any State, local, regional, or tribal government, or any instrumentality thereof (including any local educational agency or institution of higher education)."

Scope

- ☐ State and Local (S&L) governments have access to purchase via Schedules 70 and 84, at any time, for any reason, using any funds available
- □ S&L governments may purchase using grant money or State and Local funds under this program

State and Local Participation

- □ Voluntary Participation
 - No obligation by State and/or Local governments to use the schedule
 - Contractors decide whether to accept orders from State and Local governments

- □Always Open for Use
 - Meet GSA Eligible Users Criteria
 - Have State or Local Authority; granted by State or Local entity

IT Schedule 70 - Who Are We?

IT Schedule 70 grants agencies direct access to commercial experts who can thoroughly address the needs of the government IT community.

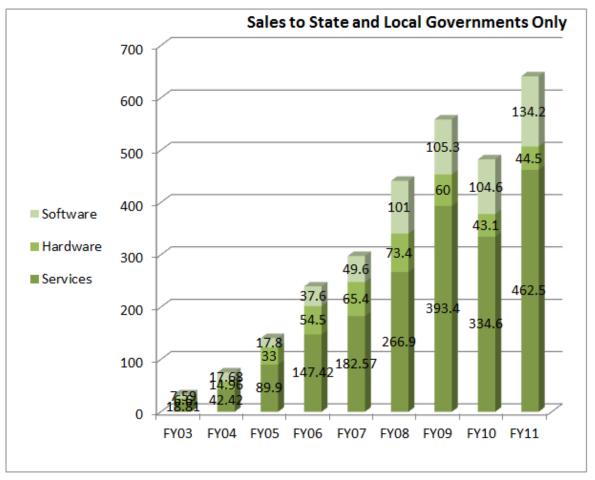

Subcategories Under Schedule 70

What is a Special Item Number (SIN)?

- □ SINs are the product and services categories within a Schedule Contract
- ☐ They are also referred to as "Categories"
- □ They are a method of categorization that groups similar products, services, and solutions together to aid in the acquisition process
- ☐ IT SINs cover the most common general purpose commercial IT hardware, software, services, and total IT solutions

Cloud IT Services

Infrastructure as a Service (laaS)

- ☐ Head-to-head competition occurred resulting in 12 awarded BPAs (BPAs cover cloud storage, virtual machines and web hosting)
- □ Requirements include 99.5% availability and Disaster Recovery and Continuity of Operations Plan

Software as a Service (SaaS)

- ☐ SaaS solutions are identified on existing Schedule 70 contracts
- □ SaaS Business and Productivity offerings include CRM, Analytics, Asset Management, Knowledge Management and Document and Content Management
- ☐ https://Apps.gov is primary source for SaaS

SmartBUY

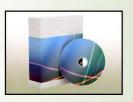
- ☐ SmartBUY (Software Managed and Acquired on the Right Terms)
- □ SmartBUY leverages software purchasing power via BPAs that were awarded via head-to-head competition
- □ Improves the configuration management, security, and standards of computers
- □ Incorporates the latest National Institute of Standards and Technology (NIST) standards
- ☐ Focuses on software; ordering entities can use Schedule 70 for hardware and complementary purchases to support the software



SmartBUY Achievements

SmartBUY currently has 24 active Blanket Purchase Agreements (BPAs):

- □ 9 of the BPAs are available for State and Local use
- ☐ Planned and recompeted BPAs will also include State and Local government end users, when possible











Since program inception, Federal agencies saved over \$1.3 Billion through SmartBUY purchases

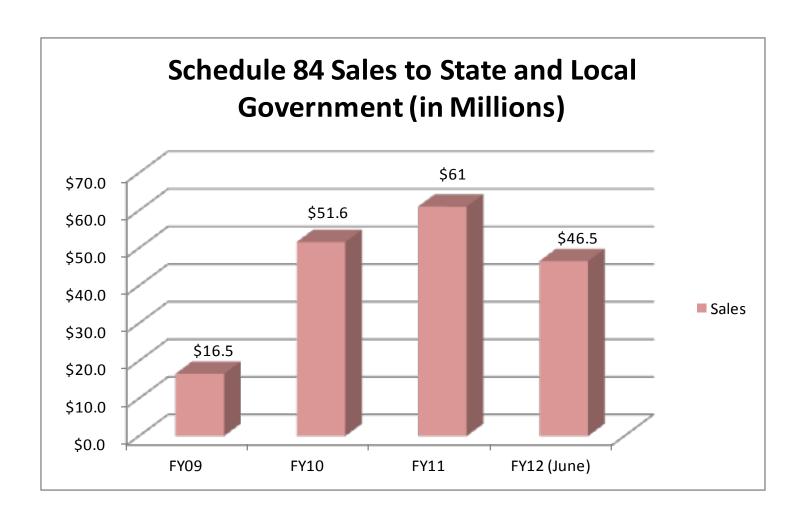
☐ What is Schedule 84?

Schedule 84 - Law Enforcement & Security - provides a variety of equipment and services across the full spectrum of Law Enforcement and Security; including facility protection, covert and overt surveillance, alarm system and all types of duty products and services.

□Why is it isolated out for the Cooperative Purchasing Program?

Public Law 110-248 of the Local Preparedness Acquisition Act authorized the cooperative purchasing by State and Local governments for economic purchase of equipment and services to better prepare the country for emergency situations

- ☐ Floating Marine Barriers, and Booms





Schedule 84: Firefighting

- All types of Urban and Wildland Firefighting Equipment and Supplies
- ☐ Flood Control Products, Medical Rescue Kits and Patient transport/immobilization devices
- ☐ Fire Extinguishing/Suppressing Products
- □ Breathing Air Equipment & Respiratory Protection Products
- ☐ Hoses, Valves, Fittings, Nozzles,Couplings and Related Accessories
- □ Aerial Search and Rescue and Aerial Firefighting Products



Schedule 84: Alarm & Signal Systems, Facility Management and Protective Service Occupations

- □ Security Systems Integration and Design Services
- □ Security Management and Support Services
- ☐ Security System Life Cycle Support
- □ Alarm and Signal Systems, Access Control Systems, Intrusion Detection Systems, Patient Wandering Detection, and Fire Alarm Systems
- ☐ Facility Management Systems including building comfort systems and integrated security system and Professional Security/Facility Management Services



Schedule 84: Special Purpose Clothing

- □ Gloves and Protective Clothing
- Hazmat Clothing
- Rainwear, Footwear
- Extreme Cold Weather Clothing
- ☐ Fire Fighting Clothing, Wildland Fire Fighting Clothing
- □ Flotation Devices
- Medical/Hospital Clothing
- □ Security Clothing, High Visibility and Reflective Products
- Industrial Work Clothing
- Concealment Clothing
- Miscellaneous Undergarments for use with Special Purpose Clothing, and Cool/Hot Clothing Products

- ☐ Night Vision Equipment

- □ Radiation / Nuclear material Detection Equipment
