#### **Scope of the Disaster Recovery Program**

- This program authorized State and Local governments access to ALL Federal Supply Schedules, when purchasing to facilitate recovery from major disasters
- □ It applies to purchases made in advance or in the aftermath of Presidentially-declared disasters or acts of terrorism
- State and Local entities may use GSA Schedules to purchase in advance of a major disaster declared by the president, as well as in the aftermath of an emergency event


#### State and Local Disaster Recovery Purchasing Program

Guidelines for State and Local governments

- □ Program participation is voluntary
- Must meet all State and Local competitive procedures and regulations when purchasing via Schedules
- FEMA Public Assistance Grant Guidance (Disaster Assistance Fact Sheet 9580.103) allows for purchasing from Federal Supply Schedules in support of major disasters

#### **Before Disaster Strikes**

What contracting vehicles do I have access to purchase from in advance of a Disaster?

- Access to ALL Schedules, in advance or in the aftermath of a disaster, as long as the S&L entity is buying to facilitate recovery
- □ Schedule BPAs for Pre-positioning
  - Selected Schedule contractors in advance and worked out agreements, terms and conditions
  - Promote vendor teaming arrangements
  - Small business concerns
