**RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON ENVIRONMENT AND PUBLIC WORKS OF
THE UNITED STATES SENATE**

that pursuant to title 40 U.S.C. § 3307, a prospectus providing for a repair and alteration project for the Joseph F. Weis, Jr. U.S. Courthouse at 700 Grant Street in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, to include the replacement of the heating, ventilation, and air conditioning and associated electrical systems, and the replacement of a section of the roof and the installation of a fall arrest system and lightning protection, for an additional cost of \$4,208,000, and for a new estimated total project cost of \$55,907,000, a description of which is attached hereto and by reference made part of this resolution, is approved. This resolution amends Prospectus No. PPA-0158-PI24.

Provided further, that the Administrator shall provide to the Chairman or Ranking Member of the Committee on Environment and Public Works of the Senate, in a timely manner, requested documents and information regarding this prospectus and resulting contractual materials, without redaction other than redactions to exclude business confidential, proprietary, and/or procurement sensitive information.

Provided further, that the Administrator shall not delegate to any other agency the authority granted by this resolution.
