

# COMMITTEE RESOLUTION

## ALTERATION 1800 F STREET FEDERAL BUILDING WASHINGTON, DC PDC-0021-WA26

### RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON ENVIRONMENT AND PUBLIC WORKS OF THE UNITED STATES SENATE

that pursuant to title 40 U.S.C. § 3307, a prospectus providing for a repair and alteration project at the Federal Building, located at 1800 F Street, NW in downtown Washington, DC, to include the final phase of the infrastructure modernization supporting the O and 3 wings and provides for the opportunity to backfill and consolidate space for federal agencies to maximize space utilization, for an estimated total project cost of \$239,000,000, a description of which is attached hereto and by reference made part of this resolution, is approved.

*Provided* further, that the Administrator shall provide to the Chairman or Ranking Member of the Committee on Environment and Public Works of the Senate, in a timely manner, requested documents and information regarding this prospectus and resulting contractual materials, without redaction other than redactions to exclude business confidential, proprietary, and/or procurement sensitive information.

*Provided* further, that the Administrator shall not delegate to any other agency the authority granted by this resolution.
