ALTERATION HENRY M. JACKSON FEDERAL BUILDING SEATTLE, WA PWA-0101-SE25


RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON ENVIRONMENT AND PUBLIC WORKS OF THE UNITED STATES SENATE

that pursuant to title 40 U.S.C. § 3307, a prospectus providing for a repair and alteration project for the Henry M. Jackson Federal Building located at 915 2nd Avenue, Seattle, Washington, to replace the fire alarm control system and fire pumps, for an estimated total project cost of \$17,487,000, a description of which is attached hereto and by reference made part of this resolution, is approved.

Provided further, that the Administrator shall provide to the Chairman or Ranking Member of the Committee on Environment and Public Works of the Senate, in a timely manner, requested documents and information regarding this prospectus and resulting contractual materials, without redaction other than redactions to exclude business confidential, proprietary, and/or procurement sensitive information.

Provided further, that the Administrator shall not delegate to any other agency the authority granted by this resolution.
