## RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON ENVIRONMENT AND PUBLIC WORKS OF THE UNITED STATES SENATE

that pursuant to title 40 U.S.C. § 3307, a prospectus providing for a repair and alteration project for the Jacob K. Javits Federal Office Building Complex located at 26 Federal Plaza, New York, New York to include the upgrade the legacy fire alarm system in approximately half of the Jacob K. Javits Federal Office Building Complex to match the modern fire alarm system partially installed, demolish and abate select space and build out new space for both the Department of Justice Antitrust Division and the National Labor Relations Board, respectively, for an estimated total project cost of \$37,195,000, a description of which is attached hereto and by reference made part of this resolution, is approved.

*Provided* further, that the Administrator shall provide to the Chairman or Ranking Member of the Committee on Environment and Public Works of the Senate, in a timely manner, requested documents and information regarding this prospectus and resulting contractual materials, without redaction other than redactions to exclude business confidential, proprietary, and/or procurement sensitive information.

*Provided* further, that the Administrator shall not delegate to any other agency the authority granted by this resolution.
