
VETS 2 FY2024 Capabilities & Credentials Survey Results

The VETS 2 Industry Partners were surveyed for fiscal year 2023. The purpose of this survey is to update the core capabilities, company certifications, and qualifications for current SDVOSB industry partners still on contract. This survey will be used to communicate with customers and stakeholders to highlight the contract capabilities. All 36 SDVOSB industry partners responded to the survey. The survey results are depicted below in graph format.

The top four core competency types of IT Services are: IT Operations and Maintenance, Management Consulting, Implementation, Cybersecurity, and Software Development. Industry partners on the VETS 2 contract have successfully performed in a variety of IT Services, the top five areas of past performance include: Cybersecurity/CyberOps, Program/Project & Portfolio Management, IT Service Desk, Agile Software Development, IT Transformation Roadmapping and Project Management Office Support. Of the 36 industry partners, 34 hold a secret or top secret security clearance. There are 29 companies that have an audited and approved cost accounting system. The top customers that our industry partners have been working with are DoD, DHS, Army, VA, and Air Force.




Industry Partners' Core Competency per IT Service



Of the following technologies, which does your company have relevant experience performing?




Which Certifications does your company currently hold?




Which Facility Clearance level does your company currently hold?
