Extended Order Options

Allows ordering activities and MAS contractors to continue orders up to 60 months after the base MAS contract has expired

February 2016

Contract Continuity Initiative

Helps address the problem of an expiring FSS contract by allowing a contractor to submit an offer at any time during the existing contract's period of performance

June 30th, 2016

Expansion of Eligible Ordering Activities to Include Commonwealth of Puerto Rico

Authorizes Puerto Rico to purchase via the Federal Supply Schedules (FSS)

February 2016

Streamlined Processes

Creates a streamlined process and set of requirements for successful FSS contractors submitting an offer for a new contract under the same Schedule

February 2016

Commercial Supplier Agreement (CSA) Class Deviation

Mitigates the legal risk of incorporating 15 common CSA terms and conditions that conflict with or are incompatible with Federal law into GSA contracts

January 2016

30 day Advanced **Notice Policy**

Requires GSA to notify contractors of changes to Schedules 30 days in advance of the change, encouraging communication and feedback

October 1st. 2015

Launched Professional Services Schedule

Reduces eight single Schedules contracts into one, easy to use contract - introduced the concept of complementary SINs to facilitate the procurement of total professional services solution

May 2015

Collection of **Standard Part** Numbers (SPNs) for Products

Allows government buyers to more easily find and compare like products and prices on Schedules

May 2015

Horizontal Pricing Analysis Tool

Provides MAS contracting officers (COs) with additional data to pass on to MAS suppliers so they can be as competitive as possible

May 26th, 2015

CALC Tool Launch

Helps the federal contracting community make smarter, faster buying decisions using a labor category and pricing research tool

January 2015

PSS SIN-Specific Ordering Guides

Developed several SIN-specific ordering/implementation guides in collaboration with ordering agencies to facilitate the procurement of high quality, competitively priced professional services

MAS Performance Dashboard

Offers searchable and filterable information for our supplier base via a public, user-friendly dashboard

Automated Price Reduction Modifications
